Proposed development at **Greatmoor Farm At Southern End Of WRG'S Ownership Of Land At Calvert; Disused Railway Line To A41, Pit 6 Of Calvert Landfill Site , Brackley Lane, Calvert.**

I give notice that **Waste Recycling Group Limited** is applying for planning permission for **Energy from waste facility; incinerator bottom ash processing; air pollution control residue treatment; access road from A41, revision to pit 6 restoration contours and restoration scheme, surface water management and habitat management and that the application is accompanied by an Environmental Statement.**

The proposed development does not accord with the provisions of the development plan in force in the area in which the land to which the application relates is situated.
