BCC Cabinet – Have you no shame?

BCC Cabinet has recently revealed the true cost of the unwanted mass burn waste incinerator (MBI) at over £200 million of ratepayers' money – for which the cabinet are setting aside many millions of pounds each year whilst they make savage budget cuts affecting every family in the county.

Martin Tett Cabinet Member for Planning and Environment claims that the sums set aside are like paying for a mortgage on a house. However MBI is no house which the county will be the proud owners of.
