Update: Plea to Bucks County Council OSCC: Stop the Titanic!!

Bernwood Forest, Buckinghamshire.

At tomorrow's 11th hour Overview and Scrutiny Committee Hearing, Cllr John Cartwright will call witnesses to ask the OSCC to help bring to a halt the doomed Titanic waste incinerator at Greatmoor farm, North Bucks.

His declared witnesses include John Bercow, Speaker of the House of Commons, members of SAVI's legal team, Will Kellett representing local parish councils, Dr Raymond Gemmell of ERAP (ecologist and environmentalist), Sir Edmund Verney of Claydon House, and Guy Jackson of Reclaim Resources, which offers a clean green cheaper alternative (less than half the price of the overblown incinerator).

Maggi Campbell-Keith SAVI spokesperson says 'Local parish councils are united in their opposition to this expensive, redundant, damaging technology of mass burn incineration. They have been ignored and brushed aside by BCC throughout this process – we now have a tiny window of an opportunity to stop the Titanic before it sets sail and costs the Council millions of wasted ratepayers money.
